Helmsley Castle first existed in 1120 and was constructed from timber. The castle evolved over the centuries, from a mighty medieval fortress to a luxurious Tudor mansion, to a Civil War stronghold and a romantic Victorian ruin. We were commissioned by English Heritage to construct a completely new visitor centre of curved design with full height glass screens, natural stone walls and cedar cladding. The project is further enhanced by the ornate curved roof combining natural slate and traditional lead work.
