This delightful project was to construct a new church hall at the rear of Holy Cross Church, Swainby which was originally consecrated on 4th October 1877. The building had to be constructed in such a way that it would compliment the church fabric and this was achieved by using a combination of brick and stone detailing. The building itself can accommodate 100 people seated and has excellent kitchen facilities. It was also a privilege to have William Hague Member of Parliament for Richmond (Yorks) attend a "topping out" ceremony to help fix the last of the ridge tiles.
